Ukrproduct Group Ltd is one of the leading Ukrainian producers and distributors of branded dairy foods and beverages (kvass, a traditional fermented beverage). The Group's product portfolio includes processed and hard cheese, packaged butter, skimmed milk powder (SMP) and kvass. Ukrproduct has built a range of recognisable product brands (“Our Dairyman”, “People’s Product”, “Creamy Valley”, Molendam”, “Farmer’s”) that are well known and highly regarded by consumers. The Group has modern production facilities that comprise four dairy plants in western and central regions of Ukraine (Zhytomyr, Starokonstantyniv, Krasyliv and Letychiv) with a total annual integrated capacity of approximately 60,000 tons of dairy products. With its own fleet of more than 200 vehicles, Ukrproduct has one of the largest logistics and distribution networks in Ukraine which covers the country's eight major cities. The Group reported total assets of approximately GBP 35.2 million as at June 30, 2013 and consolidated revenues of approximately GBP 24.7 million for the six months ended June 30, 2013. Ukrproduct's securities are traded under the symbol “UKR” on AIM, a market operated by the London Stock Exchange.
